



COURSE DELEGATE AND HOST GOLF PROFESSIONAL

FORMAT: Low Gross / Low Net - Flighted

1. Using the HOST Course Handicap Table, convert the called in index to course handicap. (Max.34).
2. Flight players. The first flight may have less due to handicap spread, but try to keep the other flights even. (Approximately 12 to a flight).Flights are to be split by INDEX, not handicap, meaning some converted course handicaps may be in different flights.
3. Prepare scorecards, pairing sheets, cart assignments and scoreboard. Try to pair players with women from different clubs. Post pairings and cart assignments in several locations.
4. Have a copy of "GCWGA Rules" on each cart. (Rules can be downloaded www.gcwga.com). Please do not alter "Winter Rules" to "Through the Green".
5. Please have someone on the course occasionally to check pace of play which has been a problem.
6. You need at least four people to register players when they arrive, and assist in checking and posting scores upon completion of play. Both functions need to run rapid and smooth.

7. AFTER PLAY

Select winners: **1st Gross / 1st Net – 2nd gross / 2nd Net** etc. Post ties accordingly, not breaking ties.
